Commonwealth in the Superior Court
of said County, came into Court & gave
the said Court to understand & be inform-
ed, that a certain George Dove, merchant,
of the County aforesaid, on the 20th day of
~~January~~ ^{April} in the year 1812 at the Store of
the said Dove in the County aforesaid,
& within the jurisdiction of the said Court,
did unlawfully & without having a license
therefor, retail & sell spirituous liquors,
to wit, wine, whiskey, cider, beer, rum
& brandy, & mixtures thereof by the half
pint & pint, to be drunk at the place
where sold, to wit, at the Store of the
said Dove in the County aforesaid, con-
trary to the act of the General Assem-
bly in that case made & provided, &
against the peace & dignity of the
Commonwealth.
