Be it remembered that on the 26th day of
April, in the year 1813, Priscus G. Baldwin, the
attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth in the
Superior Court of said County came into Court,
& gave the said Court to understand & be in-
formed, that a certain George Dove, merchant
of the County aforesaid, on the 20 day of
January in the year 1812 at the store of the
said Dove in the County aforesaid, & within
the jurisdiction of the said Court, did unlaw-
fully, & without having a licence therefor, re-
tail & sell spirituous liquors, to wit, wine
whiskey, cider, rum, beer & brandy, & mix-
tures thereof, by the half pint, & pint, to
be drank at the place where sold, to wit,
at the store of the said Dove, in the County
aforesaid, contrary to the act of the Gen-
eral Assembly in that case made & pro-
vided, & against the peace & dignity of the
Commonwealth.

This information is filed by the
order of the Court, on the
presentment of the grand jury.
