wound and ill treat the ~~John~~ Loker to wit with clubs fists &c  
so that his life was greatly endangered of and thus impairs to him  
the ~~John~~ Loker then and there did against the Peace and dis-  
unity of the Commonwealth and to the well estate of  
all others in like case offending
