or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of
Virginia and his Successors to wit the Said
Charles Hoy in the Sum of Two hundred Dollars
John Hoy in the Sum of Two Hundred Dollars and
Zachariah Hoy in the Sum of Two Hundred Dollars
to be respectively levied of their several Goods
and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use
of the Commonwealth aforesaid if ~~default~~ ^{should}
~~be made~~ by the Said Charles Hoy Should fail
in performing the Conditions under written

The Conditions of this Recognizance is Such
that if the above bound Charles Hoy Shall
personally appear at the next Court to be
holden in and for the County of Rockingham
Aforesaid to pay and receive what Shall then
and there be enjoined him by the Said Court

and in the mean while I shall keep the
peace towards the Commonwealth & all its
Citizens and Especial toward Gordon
Newill name of said County in the said County
then this said recognizance to be void Else to
remain in full force

Commonwealth & chiefly towards the said
Gordon McWilliams Given under my
Hand this 10 day of Augt 1816
