to be respectively levied of their several Goods
and Chattels Lands and tenements to the use
of the Commonwealth Aforesaid if ~~default~~ should
~~be made by the said Charles Hoy Should fail~~
in performing the conditions underwritten

The Conditions of this Recognition is such
that if the above bound Charles Hoy Shall
personally appear at the next Court to be
held in and for the County of Rockingham
Aforesaid to do and receive what shall then
and there be enjoined him by the said Court

and in the mean while shall keep the
peace towards the Commonwealth & all its
Citizens and especial toward Gordon
Mcwilliams of Saad County in the said County
then thie laid recognizance to be void Ele to
remain in full force }

the receipt hereof you bring the said John & Charles
May before me or some other Justice of the peace
the first Justice as well for ^{the} ~~the~~ personally affix
at the next Court to be holden for the said
County as also for their keeping the peace in
the mean time towards the citizens of this
Commonwealth & Charibly towards the said
Gordon Mculliams Given under my
hand this 10 day of August 1816
