

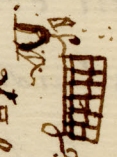
Rockingham County to wit Memorandum that upon this 2nd day

came before me Archibald Rutherford a Justice of the peace for the

of Virginia and his successors in office in the sum of Two hundred
Dollars to be Levied of his Goods and Chattles Lands and Tenements to
the use of the said Commonwealth Upon Condition that if he the
Said Thomas Jones doth personally appear before the Commonwealths
Justices of the peace for the said County of Rockingham on Thursday
the 10th day of this Month at a court by them to be held ~~by them to~~
~~be held~~ at the Court house of the said County for the Examination
of Jeremiah Warren who was committed to the goal of this County
on Suspicion of Felony and stands charged with feloniously Stealing
a Mare the Property of ^{Pharben} ~~William~~ Sandy of the Value of Eighty five
Dollars and do then and there on behalf of the ^{Said} Commonwealth give such
evidence as he knoweth against the said Jeremiah Warren concerning
the matters wherewith he is charged and that he depart not without
Leave of the said Court then this recognizance to be void else to
remain in full force
