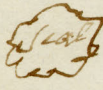


Rockingham County to wit

and to the keeper of the jail of the said County

These are to command you, the said Abraham Strickler
in the name of the Commonwealth, to convey and deliver
into the Custody of the said keeper of the said jail the body
of Will a Slave belonging to Daniel Harshman
of the County aforesaid. Charged before me with ~~stealing~~
~~and~~ feloniously stealing and taking away ^{out of the house} One Silver Watch,
one pair Green Morocco shoes, one Japan^{tin} box, two glass
tumblers, one piece Seal Leather, one piece upper Leather,
one yellow & Red striped Handkerchief. The property of
Henry Pince Linn. of the County aforesaid and you the
said jailor are hereby required to receive the said Will into
~~the custody~~ your jail and Custody, and him there safely to
keep, till he shall thence be discharged by due Course of
Law Given under my hand and seal this 7th day
of May 1816 and in the 40 year of the Commonwealth

Recognizance

Rockingham County to wit
Memorandum that upon this seventh day of May in
the year 1816 Henry Pence and Geo. Conrad
of the County aforesaid came before me Jacob Pears a jus-
tice of the peace for the County and each of them for
his proper person acknowledge himself indebted to Wilson
Cary Nicholas Esqr. Governor or Chief Magistrate of
the Commonwealth of Virginia and his Successor in
the sum One hundred Dollars each to be levied severally
of each of their good and Chattles land and tenements respect-
ively to the use of the Commonwealth; upon Conditions
that if each of them ^{do} personally appear before the Com-
monwealth justice of the peace for the said County
of Rockingham on Monday the thirtieth of May (Inst.)
at a Court by them to be held at the Court house of the
said County for the examination of Bill a Negro
Slave belonging to Daniel Hashman of the S.D. County
and do then and there on behalf of the said Common-
wealth give such evidence as the Knowledge against
the said Bill concerning the matter whereinwith he is
charged and that neither he or either of them do de-
part without leave of the said Court when this recog-
nizance to be void else to remain in full force.
