The Jurors for the body of the County aforesaid, upon their oath present, that Sally Rush of the Parish of Rockingham, ~~and in the County~~ of Rockingham Spinster, being a person of evil name and fame, and of dishonest conversation, and a common buyer ^{and receiver} of stolen goods, on the 1st day of June, in the year of our Lord 1816, about the hour of ten in the night of the same day, with force and arms, at the parish aforesaid, in the County of Rockingham aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, holden for the District of County, Eighteen yards of Hemp Lining, of the value of ~~Forty~~ Fifteen dollars, of the goods and chattels of one William Jenkins, by a certain evil disposed person, to the Jurors aforesaid as yet unknown; then lately before, feloniously stolen, also Twenty one yards of Flax Lining, of the value of twenty dollars, and ~~Twenty~~ Fifteen yards of Diaper Lining of the value of fifteen dollars, of the goods and chattels of one Joshua Hring, by a certain evil disposed person, to the Jurors aforesaid as yet unknown, then lately before, feloniously stolen, of the same evil disposed person, unlawfully, unjustly, and for wicked gain sake, did receive and have (She the said Sally Rush well knowing the said Hemp Lining, the said Flax Lining, and the said Diaper Lining to have been feloniously stolen) to the great damage of the said William Jenkins, and the said Joshua Hring, and against the form of the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia

This Indictment is found on the testimony of William Jenkins Menonah Hring, Hugh Belus, Sally Belus Conrad Hutton an ~~extra~~ ^{extra} witnesses sent up to the Grand Jury by order of the Court
