them the said Henry Yutcher & Benjamin H. Owens  
There are therefore on the behalf of in the name of the  
Commonwealth to command you, that immedi-  
ately on the receipt hereof you bring the said  
Henry Yutcher & Benjamin<sup>th</sup> Owens before me,  
to find surety ~~of the peace~~ as well for their person-  
al appearance at the next court to be holden  
for said County, as also for keeping the peace, in  
the mean time, towards the citizens of this com-  
monwealth, & chiefly towards the said George  
Crim Given under my hand & seal this 1<sup>st</sup>  
day August 1817

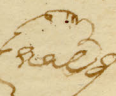
Rockingham Ct. to wit Be it remembered that on 2<sup>d</sup> day of August  
in the year 1817 Henry Gutchler of the Ct. aforesaid & Joseph  
Graham of the same & Abraham Fisher of the same ~~place~~ Ct. came  
before me, one of the commissioners of the peace for the  
Ct. aforesaid, & acknowledge themselves to owe James P. Preston  
esq. governor of the Magistrate of the commonwealth of  
Virginia, & his successors, to wit, the said Henry Gutchler  
the sum of one hundred Dollars & the said Joseph Graham  
~~the sum~~ of fifty Dollars & the said Abraham Fisher the sum of fifty  
Dollars, current money of Virginia, to be respectively levied  
& made of their several good & chattels, lands & tenements  
to the use of the commonwealth aforesaid, if he the said Hen-  
ry Gutchler shall fail in performing the conditions under  
written.

The conditions of this recognisance is such that if  
the above bounden Henry Gutchler shall personally appear at  
the next court to be holden in & for the county of Rockingham  
aforesaid, to do & receive what shall then & there be enjoined on him  
by the said court, & in the mean time to keep the peace, & be of good  
behaviour toward the commonwealth & all its citizens, & especially  
towards George Crim: then the above obligation shall be void or  
else remain in full force
