Whereas Christian Nodes of the County aforesaid hath this day given information upon oath to me Giles Tinsley a Justice of the Peace for the said County of Rockingham that on the day of November last past that William Brown of the aforesaid County Laboures did steal and feloniously take and carry off fifteen yards of raw Linen there are therefore in the name of the common Weath to require you to apprehend the said William Brown and bring him before me or some other Justice of the Peace for this County to answer the premises and further to be dealt with according to Law given under my Hand and seal 24th day of Dec^r 1816

safely to keep till he shall thence be discharged by due course of Law given
under my Hand and Seal this 24th day of December 1846
