Whereas Aggy (a free black woman) of Harrisonburg in S^c County hath personally appeared before me Joseph Cravens one of the Commonwealt^h Justices of the peace for said County and hath Taken a corporal oath that she the said Aggy is afraid (Judy another free black woman) of said Town, will beat her or do her some bodily hurt, and hath therefore prayed Surety of the peace against her, the said Judy; There are therefore on behalf and in the name of the Commonwealth to command you that immediately on the receipt hereof You bring the said Judy before one or some other Justice of the peace for said County to find Surety as well for her personal appearance at the next Court to be holden for said County, as also for her keeping the peace in the mean time towards the Citizens of this Commonwealth & chiefly towards the said Aggy.
