The Jurors for the body of the county afo^r in solemn form present that Rees Alstot late of the parish of Rockingham in the said county of Rockingham Labourer on the 1 day of September in the year 1817 at the parish afo^r in the county afo^r and within the Jurisdiction of this court w^h breach of the peace then & there did commit by unlawfully playing at a game ^{called} of cards to wit in a house ^{near} ~~in~~ Steeles town in which a carding machine was formerly worked by a certain Anthony Hoffmann ^{contrary to the Statute in such case made & provided} the same being a publick place, & against the peace and dignity of the commonwealth & to the evil example of all others in like case offending
