Crawens late of the parish of Rockingham in the
said county of Rockingham Blacksmith on the first
day of Aug^r 1817 at the parish of Rockingham in the said
county of Rockingham and within the Jurisdiction of
this Court a breach of the peace then and there
did commit by unlawfully playing a Game called
Cards to wit in the woods near the ~~ground~~
Camp Ground at Taylors Springs being a public
place contrary to the statutes in such case
made and provided against the peace and
Dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia and
to the evil example of all other in like case
offending
