On the Motion of Andrew Truvy (and he having paid to the Clerk \$18.00) it is ordered that a Licence be granted him to keep a Tavern at his house in this County for one year ending on the first of May 1818 on his entering into bond with security in the Clerks office as the Law Directs

so formerly ~~was~~ used as a Still House being a public place ^{contrary to the Statutes in such case} and ^{indecent} ~~and~~ ^{and}
wrong thus & there did against the peace and dignity of this Com-
monwealth and to the evil example of all others in like case
offending
