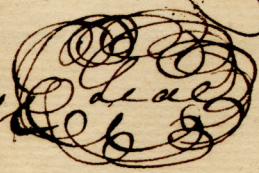


Rockingham County Mt

Whereas Nicholas Gentry in said County <sup>year</sup>  
hath personally come before me Bay Welch  
one of the Commonwealths justice appointed to  
Keep the peace in said County & hath made  
oath that ~~he~~ he the said Nicholas Gentry  
is afraid Burges Grady & Simon Grady in  
said County, labourer will beat him or do him some  
bodily hurt, and hath therefore prayed surety of the peace  
against him the said Burges Grady & Simon Grady  
I have therefore on the behalf and in  
the name of the Commonwealth to command you  
that immediately upon the receipt hereof you bring  
the said Burges Grady & Simon Grady before me  
to find surety, as well for his personal appearance  
at the next court to be holden for the said  
County, as also for his Keeping the peace, in the mean  
time towards the citizens of this Commonwealth and  
chiefly towards the said Nicholas Gentry. Given  
under my hand and seal ~~at~~ at Harrisonburg in  
the County aforesaid the 29<sup>th</sup> day of August in the  
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred &  
eighty

Rockingham County To wit

Be it remembered that on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August  
1818 Limcon Grady of said county and John  
Grady of the county aforesaid came before  
me one of the commonwealths justices of the  
peace for the county aforesaid and acknowledged  
themselves to owe James P. Preston Esq<sup>r</sup> governor  
or chief magistrate of the commonwealth  
of Virginia and his successors to wit the said  
Limcon Grady — the sum of fifty dollars  
and the said John Grady the sum of fifty  
dollars current money of Virginia to be  
respectively levied and made of their ~~respective~~  
several goods and chattels lands and tenements  
to the use of the commonwealth aforesaid if  
he the said Limcon Grady shall fail in  
performing the conditions underwritten —  
The condition of this recognizance is such that  
if the above bound Limcon Grady shall person-  
ally appear at the next court to be holden  
in and for the county of Rockingham aforesaid  
to do and receive what shall then  
and there be enjoined him by the said court  
and in the mean time shall keep the peace  
towards the commonwealth and all its  
citizens and especially towards Nicholas

recognizance shall be void or else remain  
in full force

This is to certify that it is my wish that Senour  
Grady's name should be taken out of the peace  
warrant which I ~~obtained~~ have taken out against  
D Senour Grady & Burgess Grady or that the  
bond requiring Senour Grady's appearance at  
the next Court <sup>in consequence of the above warrant by which D Senour</sup> should be given up to D Senour  
Grady so that he has no further trouble

In consequence of all my fears being removed  
as to Senour Grady wish or intention to hurt  
or injure me ~~my~~ family or any thing belonging  
to me given under my hand in presence of the  
under named witnesses
