

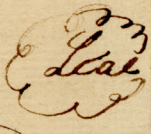
Rockingham County to wit.

To David Bramfield Constable

Thomas Burgess Grady of the said County hath personally came before me Henry Bushnell one of the commonwealths justices assigned to keep the peace in the said county and hath taken a corporal oath that he the said Burgess Grady is afraid Samuel Carrel ^{William Carrel & Pleasant Carrel} of the said county will beat him or do him some bodily hurt and hath therefore prayed surety of the peace against them the said Samuel Carrel William Carrel & Pleasant Carrel

These are therefore on the behalf and in the name of the commonwealth to command you that immediately upon the receipt hereof you bring the said Samuel Carrel William Carrel & Pleasant Carrel before me or some other Justice of the peace for said county to find surety as well for their personal appearance at the next court to be holden for the said county as also for their keeping the peace in the mean time towards the citizens of this commonwealth and chiefly towards the said Burgess Grady

It is remembered that on the 28th day August 1818 Samuel Carrel, William Carrel & Pleasant Carrel, William Bely, Philip Getts, and Nicholas Gentry all of the county aforesaid came before me one of the commonwealths justices of the peace for the county aforesaid and acknowledged themselves to owe to James P Preston Esq Governor or chief magistrate of the commonwealth of Virginia and his successors or to wit the said Samuel Carrel the sum of fifty dollars and the said William Carrel the sum of fifty dollars and the said Pleasant Carrel the sum of fifty dollars and the said William Bely the sum of fifty dollars and the said Philip Getts the sum of fifty dollars and the said Nicholas Gentry the sum of fifty dollars current money of the State of Virginia to be respectively levied and made of their several goods and chattels lands and tenements to the use of the commonwealth aforesaid if they the said Samuel Carrel, William Carrel, and Pleasant Carrel shall fail in performing the condition underwritten.

The condition of this recognizance is such that if the above bound Samuel Carrel, William Carrel and Pleasant Carrel shall personally appear at the next court to be holden for and for the county of Rockingham aforesaid to do and receive what I shall then and there be enjoined them by the said court and in the mean time shall keep the peace towards the commonwealth and all

its citizens and especially towards Burgess Grady
of the said county Then the recognizance shall
be void or else remain in full force
