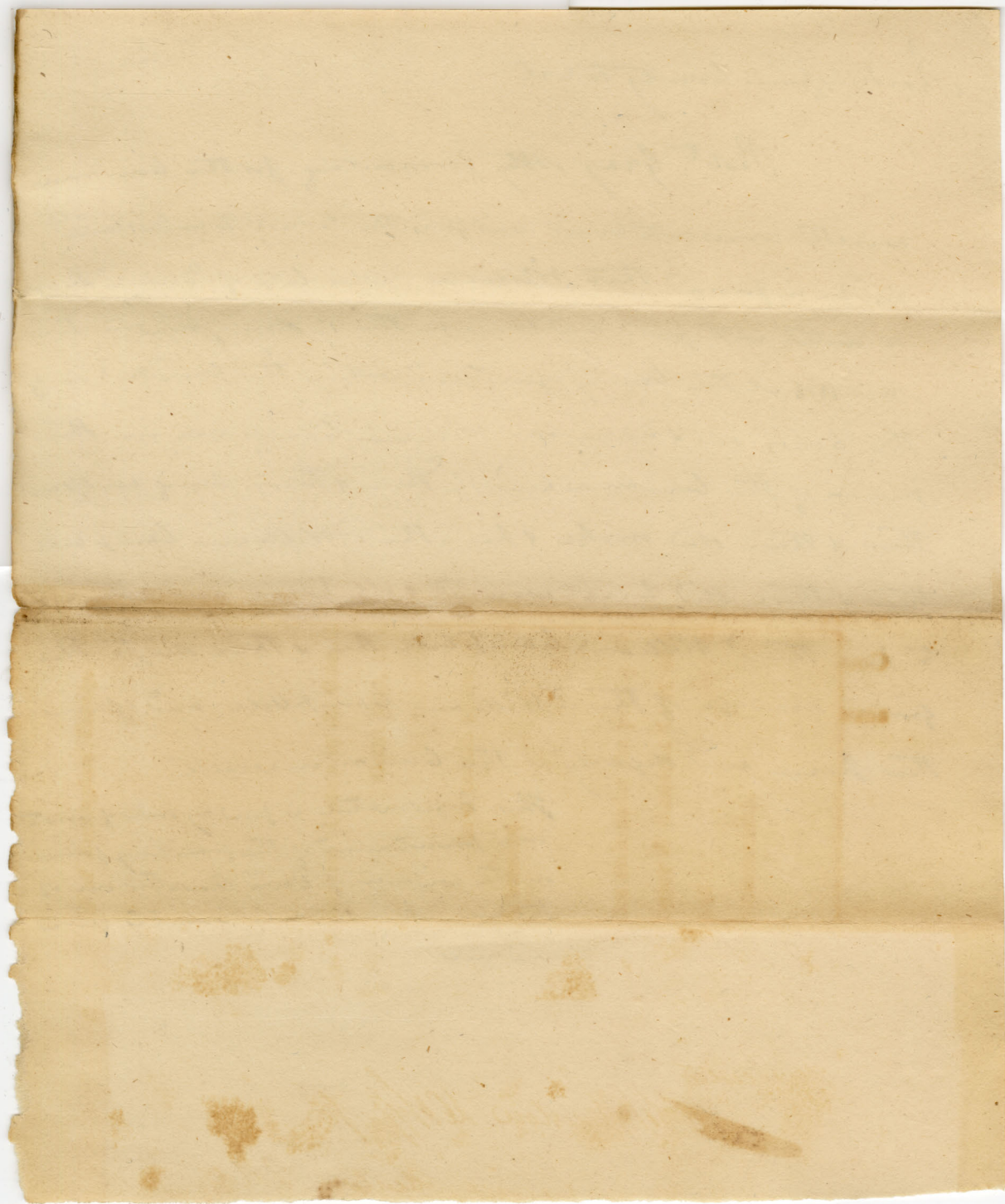


Rockingham County to wit
