To the Sheriff of the said County

Whereas James Cornwell and James Fugate late of the County of Rockingham Delinquents were this day committed to the Jail of this County by my warrant on the charge of having been guilty of a Robbery on Martin Manges in feloniously taking from the said Martin Manges a sum of the value of seven dollars and in appraising to me that the felonious offense with which they stand charged ought to be examined into by the County Court - therefore in behalf of the Commonwealth I require you that you summon at least eight of the Justices of your County to meet at the Court house on Monday the 9th of July 1818 and there & there to hold a Court for the examination of the fact with which the said James Cornwell and James Fugate stand charged and for such other purposes concerning the premises as is by Law required and directed and that you have there this warrant given under my hand and seal this 2nd day of ^{March} ~~January~~ February 1818

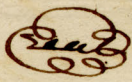

Rockingham County To wit

To the Sheriff of the said County and to the keeper
of the jail of the said County.

These are to command you the said Sheriff in the name
of the Commonwealth to convey and deliver into the custody
of the said keeper of the said jail the body of James
Cornwall, and James Fugett late of the said County
of Rockingham charged before me with forcibly
and violently taking and carrying away a certain shot
gun belonging to Martin Murger of said County and
breaking the peace by striking and turning of out of
doors from his own house the said Martin Murger
at or about ~~10 o'clock~~ of Sunday Night Jan. 25
1818. And you the jailor are hereby required to
receive the said James Cornwall and James Fugett
into your ^{Jail} Custody and there there safely keep till
they shall there be discharged by due course
of Law Given under my hand and seal this 26th
day of January 1818
