Memorandum. On this 4th day of September in the year of our
lord 1818 - personally called before me Richard Fletcher one
of the Commonwealth justices of the peace for the County of Rocking-
ham John ell Maggon of the County aforesaid ~~farmer~~ printer and
David Cummins farmer of the same County and acknowledged that they
owe to James Preston Esquire governor of ~~Virginia~~ the Commonwealth
of Virginia namely the said John ell Maggon One hundred
and Dollars and the said David Cummins Fifty Dollars
current money, to be levied of their goods & chattels, lands
and tenements, to the use of the said Commonwealth if
default is made in performance of the condition here under
written. The condition of this recognisance is such, that
if the above bound John ell Maggon shall personally
appear before the Commonwealth justices of the peace at the
next court to be held for the County of Rockingham to
answer to such matters as shall then and there ^{be} objected against
him by ~~Henry White~~ ^{any} of the said County ~~residents at law~~
concerning the assaulting, beating, and wounding ~~the~~
^{a certain} ~~second~~ Henry White, by him the said John ell Maggon
and concerning other misdemeanors tending to a
breach of the peace, and if he do not appear without leave
of the court, then this recognisance to be void ~~or~~
else to remain in full force and virtue.
