Joseph Strother James Buff Samuel Huston  
Benjamin Bryan Francis Gray Charles  
Strother George Clark Luke Rice George  
W. Harrison

appeared before me Peckey Dawson one of the Justices  
of the peace in and for the said County of Rockingham  
and acknowledged themselves to owe and be indebted to  
His Excellency James P Preston Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor of  
Virginia and his successors in office in the sum of  
fifteen Hundred Dollars that is the said Joseph  
Strother in the sum of one Thousand and Dollars and his  
said Secreteries in the sum of five Hundred Dollars  
to be levied on their respective goods and chattles  
Lands and Tenements and for the use of the Common  
wealth to be rendered yet upon this Condition that  
if the said Joseph Strother shall keep the peace  
and be of Good behaviour towards all the Good  
Citizens of this Commonwealth for the term of one  
year from the date here of then the above recogniz  
ance to be Void else to remain in full force and  
Virtue Given under our hands and Seals the  
day and year above written
