

Rockingham County to wit

Be it remembered that on the 14th day of September in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fifteen Henry White Thomas Clarke John Henry John S. Herring & David Steel in the County aforesaid came before me Richard P. Hulet one of the Commonwealth's justices of peace in and for said County and acknowledged themselves to owe James P. Preston Esq. Governor of Virginia and his successors in office to wit the said Henry White the sum of one hundred Dollars and the Thomas Clarke John Henry John S. Herring and David Steel in the sum of fifty Dollars each current money of Virginia to be respectively levied and made of their several goods and chattels, lands and tenements to the use of the Commonwealth aforesaid, if the said Henry White should fail in performing the condition underwritten.

The condition of this recognizance is such that whereas the above bound Henry White has this day been guilty of a breach of the peace in fighting with assaulting and beating John M. Hagron Now of the said Henry White shall personally appear at the next Court to be holden in and for the County aforesaid, to do and receive what shall be then and there enjoined him by the said Court and in the mean time shall keep the peace and be of good behavior towards the Commonwealth and also its citizens and especially towards John M. Hagron of the said County then the above recognizance shall be void or else remain in full force and effect.
