Whereas Fanny Kilkinney of Harrisonburg in Said County, hath personally come before me Joseph Cravens one of the Commonwealth's Justices of the peace in Said County and hath taken a corporal oath that she the Said Fanny Kilkinney is afraid John Kilkinney (her husband) of Said Town, in Said County (Shoemaker) will beat her, or do her some bodily hurt, and hath therefore prayed Surety of the peace against him, the Said John Kilkinney —

There are therefore on behalf and in the name of the Commonwealth to Command you that Immediately upon the receipt hereof You bring the Said John Kilkinney before me or some other Justice, to find Surety, as well for his personal appearance at the next Court to be holden for the Said County as also for his keeping the peace in the mean time, towards the Citizens of this Commonwealth and chiefly towards the Said Fanny Kilkinney

in Said County.

Whereas John Kilkenny of this County (Shoemaker) is
now brought before me Joseph Cravens one of the Commonwealth
Justices, assigned to keep the peace in Said County, requiring
him to find sufficient sureties to be bound with him in
recognizance for his personal appearance at the next Court
to be holden in & for Said County, and in the mean time to
keep the peace towards the Said Commonwealth and its
Citizens and especially towards Fanny Kilkenny of
Said Town & County, (his wife) And whereas he, the Said John
Kilkenny, hath refused, and doth now refuse before me, to
find such Sureties; There are therefore in the name of the
Commonwealth to Command you the Said Constable, forthwith
to convey the Said John Kilkenny, to the Common Jail of the
Said County, and to deliver him to the Keeper thereof, there,
together with this precept; And I do in the name of the
Commonwealth hereby Command you, the Said Keeper, to
receive the Said John Kilkenny into your custody, in the
Said Jail, and him there safely keep, until he shall find
such Sureties as aforesaid, or be otherwise discharged by due
course of Law. Given under my hand & Seal at Harrisonburg
in the Said County this 22nd day of December in the Year
1818 —
