the Court house on ~~the~~ ^{the} Tuesday the 24th inst
and there I there to hold a Court for the Exam-
-ation of the fact with which the said James Cun-
-ingham stands charged ~~with~~ and for such
other purposes Concerning the premises as is by
Law Required and directed and that you
have then & there this warrant from under my
hand & seal this 17 day of Augt 1819
