County Greeting: we command you that you cause Archibald  
Murphy late of the Parish and County aforesaid, to be demanded  
from County Court to County Court until according to law and  
the customs of this Commonwealth, he be outlawed, if he does  
not appear, and if he does appear, then that you take him  
and safely keep him, so that you have his body before  
the Judge of our superior Court of Law Holden for the  
said County on the fourth Monday in September next, to  
answer the Commonwealth of a certain Larceny, whereof  
he stands indicted, and have them then this writ
