The Jury for the body of the County aforesaid, on their oaths present that heretofore to wit on the 20. of April 1819. at the County aforesaid, and within the Jurisdiction of this Court, Jacob Nyron, Surveyor of that part of the road leading from Garrisonburg to Staunton, from Cools Creek to the North River in the said County, failed to keep the said road in lawfull repair, to this that the said Surveyor did not on the day and year aforesaid in the County aforesaid, keep the said road well cleared, and smooth, and thirty feet wide, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth.
