on the 10th day of May 1813 at the County afd and within the
jurisdiction of this court David Palmer a breach of the law then
and then did commit by unlawfully playing at a game called
cards to wit at a house formerly used as a Still-House and
being part of the tenement occupied by a certain Andrew
Prevey and within the curtilage of the house occupied by the
said Andrew Prevey as a Tavern the said house so formerly
used as a Still house being a public place contrary to the
Statutes in such cases made and provided and other wrongs then
and then did against the peace & dignity of the common
wealth & to the evil example of all others in like case
offending
