The Grand Jury for the body of the County aforesaid on their oaths present that herebefore to wit on the 16th day of May in the year 1812 at the County aforesaid and within the jurisdiction of this County William Vampeth a breach of the law then & there did commit by unlawfully playing at a game called cards to wit at a house formerly used as a Still House and being part of the premises occupied by a certain Andrew Trevey and within the curtilage of the house occupied by the said Andrew Trevey as a Tavern the said House is formerly used as a Still House being a public place contrary to the Statutes in such cases made and provided and other wrongs then and there done against the peace and dignity of the commonwealth and to the evil example of all others in like case offending

This indictment is supported by the evidence of Reuben Hunt a witness sent to the Grand Jury by the County
