Henderson or bearer, which said false forged and counterfeit note of the State Bank of North Carolina, is in the words, figures, cyphers and letters, following, that is to say

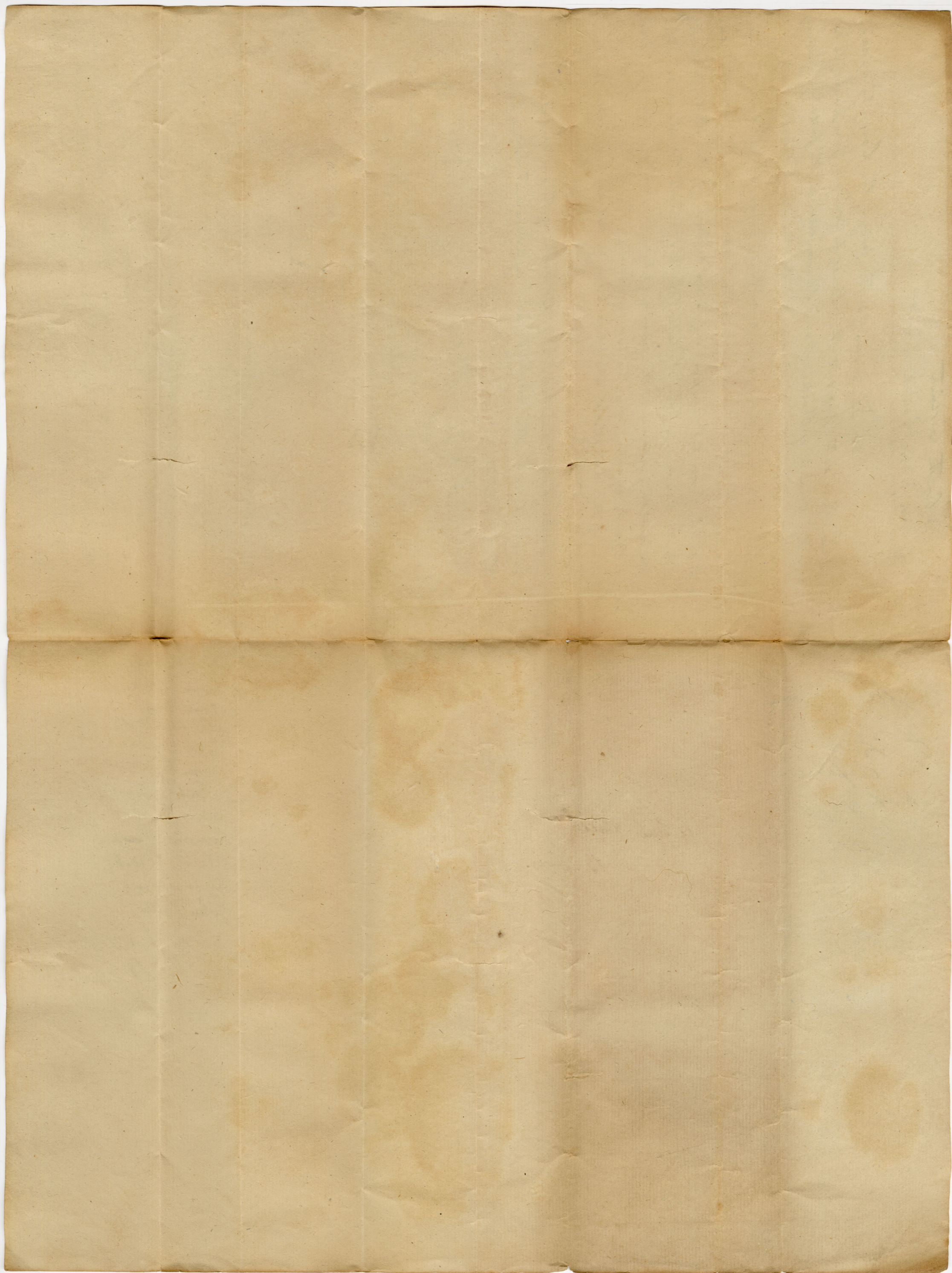

he the said Burgess Grady (a free person) afterwards, to wit on the said fourth day of February in the year eight hundred and twenty, with force and arms at the County aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with intention to injure and defraud a certain George Letimore of the County of Rockingham, the said false, forged and counterfeit note of the State Bank of North Carolina, did feloniously pass as a true note of the State Bank of North Carolina, to the said George Letimore, he the said Burgess Grady at the time he so as aforesaid passed the said false forged and counterfeit note of the State Bank of North Carolina, well knowing the same to be false, forged and counterfeit, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth and against the form of the Statute in that case made and provided.
