in the year of our Lord 1820 Thomas Lanahan
Sturges kept in said County & done before the same
~~Court~~ place Jacob Yant of the same place
Came before me Henry Welch a Justice of the
Peace for the County aforesaid & acknowledged
them selves to owe to Thomas. M. Randolph
Esq. Governor of Virginia or Chief Magistrate
of the Commonwealth of Virginia & his Successors
to wit the said Thomas Lanahan the sum of
one hundred dollars & the said Daniel Ragan the
sum of one hundred dollars & the said Jacob Yant
in the sum of one hundred dollars — Current Money
of Virginia to be respectively levied & made of
their several goods & Chattels Lands & Tenements to
the use of the Commonwealth aforesaid if
in the said Thomas Lanahan shall fail in per-
forming the Condition under written
The Condition of this Recognizance is such that if
the above bound Thomas Lanahan shall ~~appear~~ personally
appear at the next Court to be holden in & for the
County aforesaid to do & perform what shall there
and there be required and herein by the
said Court and in the mean time
shall keep the Peace as he is bound
likewise he shall keep the Peace

and in of good behavior to ward the
common with and all its citizens
and especially towards the black of
the Town of Barnstable in said
County thus this Recognizance
shall be void on Remain in full
force

Whereas Mr Colclark of Harrisonburg in Pleaunty
hath personally appeared before me Henry Welch one of the
commonwealths justices ~~of the peace~~, assigned to keep
the peace in the 1st County, and hath taken a corporal
oath that he the 1st John Lenchaw is afraid Thomas
Lenchaw of Harrisonburg in the 1st County Tavern
Keeper will beat him wound, maim, kill or do
him some bodily hurt, and hath therefore prayed
surety of the peace, against him the 1st Tho Lenchaw

There are therefore ~~in~~ the behalf, and in the
name of the commonwealth to command you
that immediately on the Receipt hereof, you bring
the 1st Tho Lenchaw before me to find surety
as well for his personal appearance at the next
Court, to be holden for the 1st County, as also for his
keeping the peace in the mean time, towards
the citizens of this commonwealth and chiefly
towards the 1st Mr Colclark Given under my hand
and Seal at Harrisonburg in the 1st County the 10th
day of August in the year 1820
