Whereas Charles Williams, late of Orange County, was this day
committed to the jail of this County, by my warrant, it appear-
ing to me, that the felonious offence wherewith he stands charged
ought to be examined into by the county court; therefore, on behalf
of the Commonwealth, I require you, that you summon at
least eight of the justices of your said County to meet
at the courthouse on the 15th day of this present month
(August) and then and there to hold a court for the examination
of the ^{felony} ~~fact~~ with which the said Charles Williams stands
charged, and for such other purposes concerning the prem-
ises, as is by law required and directed; and that you
have then and there this warrant - Given under my hand
and seal this 9th day of August 1820. in the 45th year of

Gancey - You are, therefore, commanded to receive the
said Charles Williams into your custody in the said jail,
there to remain, till he be delivered out of your custody
by the laws of the Commonwealth. Witness Clayton Gancey
one of the Commonwealth's justices assigned to keep the peace
for the said county, at the county town, the 9th day of
August in the year 1820 and in the 45th year of the
