To wit Be it remembered that on the 1st day of April in the year of our Lord 1820 William Bryan in the county aforesaid yeoman and John Chrisman of the same place yeoman came before me ~~and~~ David Keinton one of the commonwealths Justices of the peace for the county aforesaid and acknowledged their selves to owe to Thomas Man Randolph Esq^r. Governor or Chief Magistrate of the commonwealth of Virginia and his successors to wit the said William Bryan the sum of Fifty Dollars and the said John Chrisman the sum of Fifty Dollars current money of Virginia to be respectively levied and made of their goods and chattels lands and tenements to the use of the Commonwealth aforesaid if he the said William Bryan should fail in performing the condition under written

The Condition of this Recognizance is such that if the above bound William Bryan shall personally appear at the next court to be holden in and for the county of Rockingham aforesaid to do and receive what shall then and there be enjoined him by said the said court and in the mean time shall keep the peace and be of good behavior to wards the commonwealth and all its citizens and especially to wards Mary Weyer singlewoman in the said county then the said Recognizance shall be void or else remain in full force

Whereas Mary Boyer of Said county, (Single woman) hath personally appeared before me Joseph Cravens one of the Common-wealths Justices assigned to keep the peace in Said county, and hath taken a corporal oath that she the Said Mary Boyer is afraid that William Boyer of Said county Gent: will beat her, or do her some bodily hurt and hath thereupon prayed Surety of the peace against him the Said William Boyer. These are therefore on the behalf in the name of the Commonwealth to command you, that immediately upon the receipt hereof you bring the Said William Boyer before me or some other Justice of the peace in or for Said county to find Surety of the as well for his personal appearance, at the next court to be holden for the Said county as also for his keeping the peace in the mean time, towards the Citizens of this Commonwealth & chiefly towards the Said Mary Boyer.
