Be it remembered

that on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year 1824 Henry Dedmore of — in the county aforesaid, laboured and Christian Dedmore of the same place yeoman, came before me one of the commonwealths justices of the peace for the county aforesaid and acknowledged themselves to owe to His M<sup>ty</sup> Randolph Esq<sup>r</sup> <sup>a chief magistrate of the</sup> governor of the commonwealth of Virginia and his successors, to wit, the said Henry Dedmore the sum of One hundred dollars and the said Christian Dedmore the sum of One hundred dollars current money of Virginia, to be respectively levied and made of their several goods & chattels, lands and tenements to the use of the commonwealth aforesaid, of he, the said Henry Dedmore shall fail in performing the conditions underwritten

The condition of this recognizance is such, that if the above bound Henry ~~Dedmore~~ Dedmore shall personally appear at the next court, to be holden in ~~and~~ and for the ~~said~~ county of Rockingham aforesaid, to do and receive what shall then and there be enjoined him by the said court, and in the mean time shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards the commonwealth and all its citizens, and especially towards Elizabeth Dedmore ~~his~~ wife in the said County. Then this recognizance shall be void or else remain in full force
