Rockingham County A writ
To Sheriff of said County Thomas William Keller
of this County Calamus was this day committed
to jail by warrant for felonious stealing &
Carrying away one plated snaffle bridle with
to the value of two dollars the property of
Joseph Fancutt (it appearing to me the felon
Lous offence where with he stands charged ~~with~~
ought to be Examined into by the County Court
therefore on behalf of the Commonwealth I require
you to summon at least Eight of the justices
of your said County to meet at the Court
house on ^{Saturday the 8th} ~~the 10th~~ day of September next and then
I there hold a Court for the Examination of the
fact with which the said Keller stands charged
and for such other purposes Concerning the
premises as is by Law required & directed and that
have then & there this warrant given under my
hand & Seal this 30th day of Augt 1821
