for his personal appearance at the next court to be holden for the
county, as also for his keeping the peace, in the mean time towards
the Citizens of this commonwealth and chiefly towards the said

Rockingham County Court.

Be it remembered that on the 20th day of November in the year 1822 Andrew Spitzer of the State of Virginia in the county aforesaid and Andrew Lago of the same state and county, came before me, ^{Dr P. Hallett} one of the commonwealth's justices of the peace for the county aforesaid, and acknowledged themselves to owe to Thomas M. Randolph Esq Governor or chief Magistrate of the commonwealth of Virginia, and his successors, to wit, the said Andrew Spitzer the sum of Fifty dollars and the said Andrew Lago in the sum of Fifty dollars, current money of Virginia, to be respectively lived and made of their several goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to the use of the commonwealth aforesaid, if the said Andrew Spitzer shall fail in perform the condition under written. The condition of this recognizance is such, that if the above bound Andrew Spitzer shall personally appear at the next court, to be holden in and for the county of Rockingham aforesaid to do and receive what shall then and there be enjoined him by the said court and in the mean time shall keep the peace towards the commonwealth and all its citizens and especially towards John Smith in the said County. Then the said recognizances shall be void else to remain in full force.
