he stands charged, to wit, Stealing one silver watch the property
of Lewis Lane to the Value of six Dollars one pair of cotton
Hose and handkerchief the property of Samuel Long one black
silk handkerchief the property of Josiah Reed and one saddle blan-
ket the property of Joseph Shoup on the night of the 10th Inst. at
or near the camp meeting ground, ought to be examined by
the County Court therefore on behalf of the Commonwealth
I require you to summon at least eight of the Justices of
your said County to meet at the Court house on Saturday
the 17th Inst. and then and there to hold a Court for the exam-
ination of the facts with which the said Hinley stands
charged and for such other purposes concerning the process
as is by law required from under my hand & Seal
this 11 day of Sept 1822 Henry Richey
