Memorandum on this 13 day of July 1823
David Nick & August Schoenman came before
me Henry Welch a justice of the peace
for the County aforesaid and each of them
of his proper person acknowledged their
debts indebted to James Pleasants Esq
Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia
and his successors in the sum of one
hundred dollars to be paid several of
each of their goods & chattels lands & tena-
ments respectively to the use of the said
Commonwealth upon condition that
if ~~each~~ ^{of them} do personally before the
Commonwealth justice of the peace
for the said County of Rockingham on the

Saturday the 19 day of July at a court
by them to be held at the Court house of the
County for the Examination of Archibald
McCallum blacksmith charged with
the murder of John Utter and do then &
then on behalf of the said Commonwealth
give such Evidence as they know of against
the said Archibald McCallum concerning
the matters wherein he is charged
~~of~~ ^{of them} and that neither do depart
without the leave of the said Court then
this Recognition to be valid &c to remain
in full force

To the Sheriff of said County

Whereas Archibald McColvinn was this day committed to the Jail of this County, by my warrant, it appearing to me, that the felonious offence wherewith he stands charged "to wit the murder of John Webster by beating said Webster on the head with a stick on Saturday June 13th between the hours of 4 and 5 O. Clock P. M.,) ought to be examined into by the County Court; Therefore, on behalf of the Commonwealth, I require you that you summon at least eight of the Justices of your said County to meet at the Court House, on the 15th day of July and then and there to hold a Court for the reexamination of the fact, with which the said Archibald McColvinn stands charged, and for such other purposes concerning the premises, as is by law required and directed; and that you have then there the warrant given under my hand and seal
this 13th day of July 1823

To the Sheriff of the said County, and to the
Keeper of the Jail of said County

These are to command you, the said Sheriff in the
name of the Commonwealth, to convey and deliver
into the custody of the said Keeper of the said ^{Jail}

me with the murder of John Metzler by beating
said Metzler on the head with a stick on Saturday
July 12th at McGahys Town between the hours of 4
and 5 O'Clock P.M., and you the said Jailer,
are hereby required to receive the said Archibald
