sd James Shepherd in the sum of thirty Dollars

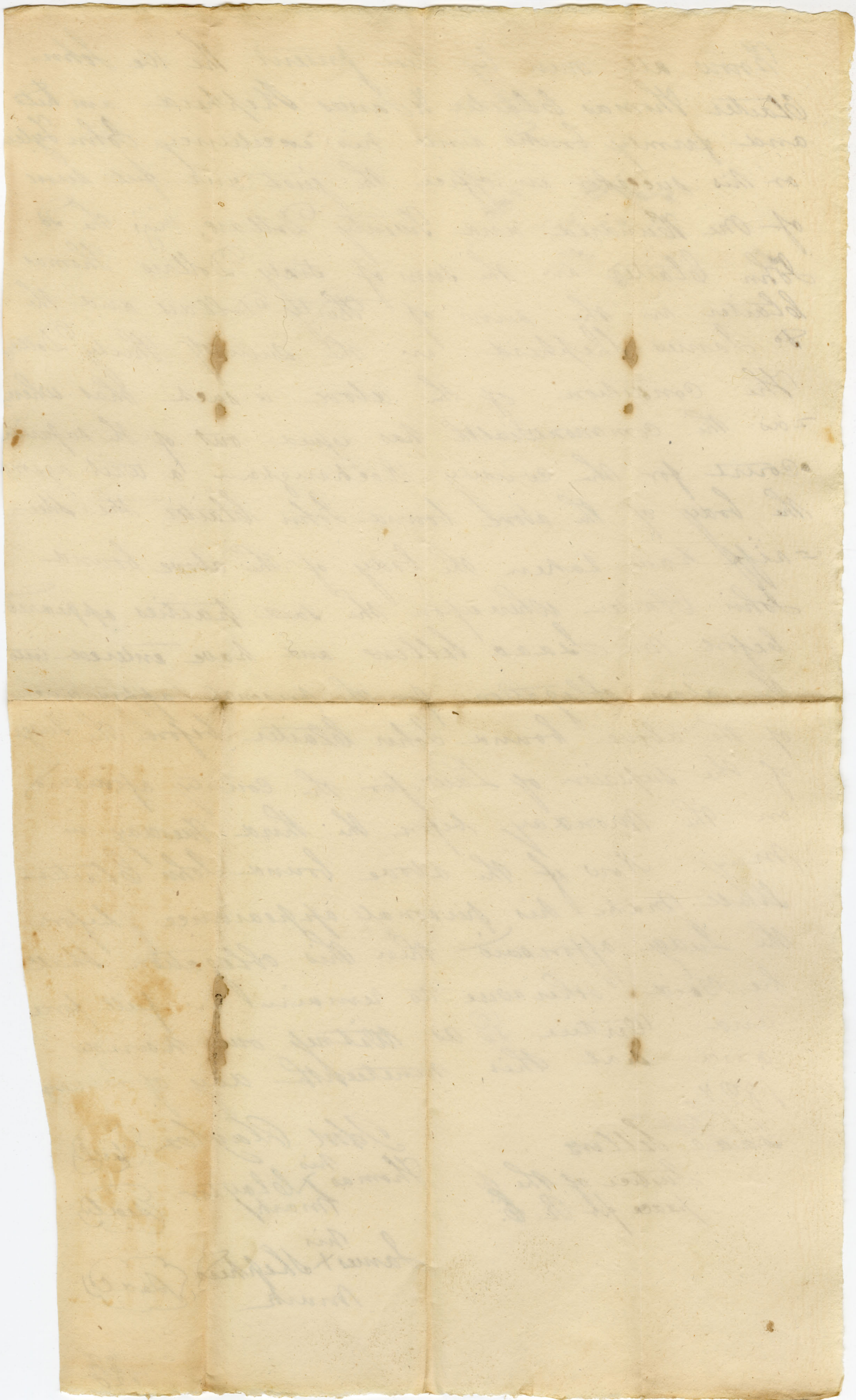
The condition of the above is such that where-
