1st day of October 1826 at the County Court and within the
jurisdiction of the Court a horse the property of a certain Larkin
Samuels Cooker was run in a race on the public highway
and the jurors given on this 10th present that at the time
the horse was so run in the race given the Larkin
Samuels was there and there present and consented to the
horse running the race, ^{to wit on the 1st day of October 1826 at the County Court} against the peace and
dignity of the Commonwealth and against the Statute
in such case made and provided, to the evil example
of all others in like case binding.
