The Condition of the above recognizance is such that whereas the above bound Patrick Kernalty is now in the custody of the said Deputy Sheriff, by virtue of a Capias, at the suit of the Commonwealth to answer on information, filed by the Superior Court of Law for the County of Rockingham, which Capias is returnable before the next Superior Court of Law for the County Now if the above bound Patrick Kernalty, shall well & truly make his personal appearance at the Court aforesaid to do and abide, the decision of the said Court then the above Recognizance to be void else remain in full force
