peace and dignity of the Commonwealth and to the
evil example of all others in like case offending

This indictment is made by the
vicar of Littleton W. Gamble
a Witness sent for, and sworn to
give evidence to the Grand Jury.

The Commonwealth of Virginia to the Sheriff of Rockingham
County Greeting: we command you that you do not omit for
any Liberty in your bailwicks, but that you take Jacob F.
Bright ~~back~~ of the said County, if he be found within your bailwicks
and him safely keep so that you have his body before the
Judge of the superior Court of Law for said County, on the
Monday before the third Tuesday in October next to answer
an indictment found against him by the Grand Jury, and have
then there the next Weekday Henry Gambill Clerk of our
said County the 24th May 1879 and in the 53rd year of the
Commonwealth
