Jewel Paul a constable in & for the County assizes whom duty it was then
& there is constable your to keep the peace and the jurors present on this
oath further present that the said Jewel Paul a constable aforesaid being then &
there present as you & did then & there seize upon the said John Miller and the
& Strom Rols who were then & there aforesaid engaged in breaking the
peace in fighting with & assaulting each other for the purpose of striking
~~them~~ ^{them} & keeping ~~them~~ ^{them} from any further course of the peace & in order
to carry them the said Miller & Rols before a justice of the peace in & for the
County assizes to be dealt with according to law for the breaking of the peace
so made as you & his this, & Jewel Pauls presence who was constable
is you & had the jurors you & on this oath further present that a certain
Dent Dinkle being then & there present at the breaking of the peace so com-
mitted & done as you & by the said Miller & the said Rols the said Jewel Paul
a constable you & them & those called upon & summoned the said Dent Dinkle
to write on the day & year first above named at the County assizes & with the
jurisdiction of this Court to aid & assist him the said Jewel Paul a con-
stable you & to take & detain the said Miller & the said Rols so that they might
be presented for fighting as you & then they the said Miller & the said
& Rols might be taken before a justice of the peace in & for the County
of Roxburgh to be dealt with according to law and the jurors you &
on this oath you & further present that the said Dent Dinkle as aforesaid
called upon & summoned as you & the justice you & by the said Jewel
Paul a constable you & the justice you & then neglected
or refused to aid & assist the said Jewel Paul a constable you & to take & aid
& detain the said Miller & the said Rols or either of them ^{by the justice you &} against the peace in &
