at the County court & within the jurisdiction of this Court a certain
John Miller & Samuel Roker were engaged in breaking the peace of the common
wealth by unlawfully fighting with & beating each other in the presence of
Jacob Paul a constable in & for the County sworn & now duty it was then
& there is constable sworn to keep the peace and the jurors sworn in this
case further declare that the said Jacob Paul is constable sworn being then &
there present is sworn did then & there seize upon the said John Miller and the
said Samuel Roker who were then & there ~~engaged~~ engaged in breaking the
peace in fighting with & assaulting each other for the purpose of striking
them in fighting is sworn
them and preventing them from any further breach of the peace and in order
to carry them the said Miller & Roker before a justice of the peace in & for the
County sworn to be dealt with according to law for the breach of the peace
so made is sworn in his then said Jacob Paul's presence who was constable
is sworn and the jurors sworn in this case further present that a certain
Daniel Double being then & there present at the breach of the peace so com-
mitted and done is sworn by the said Miller & the said Roker the said Jacob Paul is
constable sworn then & there called upon & summoned the said Daniel Double
to wit on the day & year first above named at the County court & within
the jurisdiction of this Court to aid and assist him the said Jacob Paul is con-
-stable sworn to take and detain the said Miller & the said Roker so that they might
be prevented from fighting is sworn and then they the said Miller & the said
Roker might be taken before a justice of the peace in & for the County
of Rockingham to be dealt with according to law and the jurors sworn
in this case sworn further present that the said ^{Daniel} Double is being
called upon and summoned is sworn for the purpose sworn by the said Jacob
Paul is constable sworn further present that then & there neglected
refused to aid and assist the said Jacob Paul is constable sworn to take and
detain the said Miller & the said Roker or either of them ^{for the purpose sworn} against the peace and
defiance of the common wealth & to this end examples of all
