



Know all men by these presents, that we Robert

in the penal sum of \$500, to which payment
well & truly to be made we bind ourselves our
heirs &c by these presents


The condition of the above obligation is
such that whereas the above bound
Robert Lockridge being in confinement
in the jail of the County of Augusta
& conceiving himself to be illegally im-
prisoned, hath applied to the Hon Dan^l
Smith one of the judges of the General
Court for Virginia, for a writ of habeas
corpus to carry his body before him to
enquire into the cause of his imprison-
ment, & whereas the same hath been
granted by the Hon. D. Smith, ^{on certain conditions endorsed on the writ} & the Shff of
Augusta County is about to take the
body of the said Robert Lockridge before
the Hon^l D. Smith, in the County of
Rockingham, now if the said Ro.
Lockridge shall not escape out
of the custody of the Sheriff, by the

way, & shall pay all ^{such} ~~and~~ charges
as may be awarded against him
by the Hon^d D. Smith on the trial
of the motion for his discharge
then the said bond is to be void
& else to remain in full force
& virtue. Witness our hands &
seals this 14th of May 1835

Dear Sir

There was a writ issued on the 28th July last & served on Lockridge while at this place. (believing) it might be difficult to serve it afterwards — Bond & security not having been given at the time you had better have this writ executed on Lockridge after you shall have executed the bond & security.

It is not usual to send the writs to the clerks of the Circuit Court: but they are delivered to the parties or their counsel; this will account for the writ not having been sent to the clerk at Rockingham — If you are not at our next Court please hand the writ Tax — Two dollars & fifty cents to Mr. Feltz for me —

The Commonwealth of Virginia to the Sheriff
of Augusta County Greeting Whereas Robert
Lockridge hath complained to me Daniel
Smith, one of the Judges of the General
Court, that he is illegally held in custody,
and imprisoned by you, in the jail of your
County. - These are therefore to command
you, that on receipt hereof, you do
immediately bring before me, or some other
Judge of this Commonwealth duly authorized
to proceed in this behalf, the body of
the said Robert Lockridge together with
the day and cause of his caption and
detention, then and there to do, submit
to, and receive, whatsoever may be considered
in that behalf. - Witness the said
Daniel Smith at his house in the
County of Rockingham this 25th day of
October 1834

The effect of the within writ is suspended, until
the within named Robert Lockridge shall execute a
bond to the Sheriff, with sufficient security, in
the penalty of five hundred dollars, conditioned
for the payment of such charges as may be
awarded against said Lockridge, and that he
will not escape by the way

Complaints being this day made to me
Archer P. Strother a Justice of the peace for said County
upon oath by Moser McClellan Deputy Sheriff for said
County that Robert Lockridge who was charged in Execution
in the custody of said Deputy Sheriff at the suits of the
following persons - John Earle against the said Lockridge
for Two hundred and eleven Dollars Sixty four Cents with
Legal interest from the 20th January 1831 - also Thirty five
Dollars thirty nine Cents Costs which execution issued from
the Clerks Office of the Circuit Superior Court of Law &
Chancery for Greenbrier County; Samue S Meesians
assignee of Daniel Shoffy against the said Lockridge for
Seven Dollars with Legal interest from the 7th day of June
1827 also one Dollar and seventy Cents Costs which execution
issued from the Clerks Office of the County Court of Bath
James Moore assignee of James Holden against the said
Lockridge for Two Dollars with Legal interest from the 10th
day of September 1829 also one Dollar and seventy Cents Costs
which Execution issued from the Clerks Office of the County

the prison where prisoners are usually kept in the
County where he is so retaken and deliver him to the
keeper thereof together with this warrant hereby com-
manding and requiring the said keeper to receive the
said Robert Lockridge and him safely keep in the said
Jail without Bail or mainprize until satisfaction be
made to the aforesaid parties Plaintiffs for their res-
pective Debts and Costs aforesaid or until he be there
delivered by due course of Law and to return this
warrant to the Court of the said County of Bath per-
suant to the act of the General Assembly in that
case made and provided. Given under my hand

the said Robert Lockridge his certain attorney, his executors, administrators or assigns
for the true payment whereof, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves
our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally firmly by these
presents, sealed with our seals and dated this 22nd day of December 1835.

The condition of the above Obligation is such, that Whereas
the above bound Moses McLintock hath sued out of the Court of appeals at
Lewistown in the County of Grantville a writ of Superedeas to a judgment of
the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for the County of Rockingham, recovered
~~reporter~~ ~~no error~~ against him, by the said Robert Lockridge, on the 16th day of May 1835.
on a writ of Habeas Corpus" &c. Now if the said Moses McLintock shall
prosecute the said writ with effect, & shall well and truly, do and perform
