of all others in like manner offending

the truth to say in behalf of *The Commonwealth*

in a certain matter of controversy in  
our said Court, depending and undetermined, between *The County and*  
*Abasis Stenton Defendant*

And this *She* shall in no wise omit under the penalty of £100.

And have then there this Writ. Witness HENRY J. GAMBILL, Clerk of our said Court at  
the Court-House the *10<sup>th</sup>* day of *September* 1836 and in the *61<sup>st</sup>*  
year of the Commonwealth.
