year 1836 and within the jurisdiction of this Court one Mathew Tate (some-
times called Punch Tate) feloniously did steal and take and carry away the
contents of a spirit kegs of the value of twenty dollars the property of
one Concord Sengfer then & there did kill and then and there feloniously
kissed and did take and carry away against the Statute in such case
made and provided and the Jury expressed on this oath expressed promise
that Peter Potter of the County of Rockingham on the 20 of June
in the year 1836 at the County aforesaid and within the jurisdiction
of this Court well knowing the premises did then & there receive the
said spirit kegs so stolen as aforesaid against the Statute in such
case made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the
Commonwealth
