The jurors for the body of the County afore said on this  
oath present that whereas George Shegar is a Surveyor of a portion  
of one of the public roads in the County of Rockingham to wit the  
portion of the public road which separates the said sheep pasture and  
the plantation on which Arch. Wood, J. Plummerford now resides and so forth

and the jurors afore said on this oath aforesaid further present that  
the said George Shegar is being surveyed of the said portion of  
the public road afore said, to wit on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May in the  
year 1839 and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did unlawfully  
guilt and neglect to cause the said portion of the Public road of which  
he was the Surveyor as aforesaid, on the day & year last afore said, to be kept  
well cleared and smoothed, and thirty feet wide at the least (the County  
Court of Rockingham not having by order entered of Record authorized a levy with)  
against the ~~present~~ Statute in such case made and provided and of  
course the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth

information of Joseph French and William  
D. Smith two of the grand jury.
