is the Surveyor, and the jurors aforesaid on their oath aforesaid further charge that the
said John Harrison is the owner of the land where the said fence was built by him as
aforesaid on the said part of the public road aforesaid and that he the said John Harrison
continued the said fence, so made as aforesaid, across the public road as aforesaid from the
said 1st day of ~~April~~ ^{May} 1839 to the 1st day of ~~March~~ 1839 to wit thirty times twenty four hours
