that William French alias William Watkins late of the County of
Nottingham deceased on the twenty second day of November in the
year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty seven at the County
aforesaid and within the jurisdiction of this Court in and upon one
Andrew Lamb then and there being, feloniously, voluntarily, mali-
ciously and of purpose did make an assault: And that the said William
French alias William Watkins with a certain knife of the value of
one shilling, which he in his right hand then and there had and held
the said Andrew Lamb feloniously, voluntarily, maliciously, and
of purpose did stab in and upon the left side of the body of him the
said Andrew Lamb and in and upon the left arm of him the said
Andrew Lamb, with intention in so doing, feloniously, voluntarily,
maliciously and of purpose to maim, disfigure, disable and kill him
the said Andrew Lamb against the form of the Statute in such case
made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the Com-
monwealth
