The jurors for the body of the County aforesaid on their oath present
their verdict to wit on the 7th day of May 1842 at the County of fairs and
within the jurisdiction of this Court that ^{being} said good as surveyor of this part of the
public road ~~leading~~ leading from William Ewings to the Mill known
by the name of William Hopkins's Mill in the County aforesaid and within the
jurisdiction of this Court, permitted the s^d part of the public road to be and remain
out of order in this that on the day & year aforesaid at the County of fairs and within the
jurisdiction of this Court the ^{Deputy} ~~good~~ ^{good} as surveyor ~~did~~ ^{did} not cause this s^d part of the
public road to ^{be kept} well cleared and smoothed and thirty feet wide (The County Court
of Rockingham never having by order entered of record authorized the s^d part or any part
of s^d public road to be made less than thirty feet wide) against the form of the
Statute in such case made and provided and against the peace and dignity
of the Commonwealth
