The jurors for the body of the County agreed
on this 1st day of October that Charles Abraham Threlkeld is the owner
of that part of the public road in the County of Rockingham
which begins opposite the house of Daniel Bolles and
ends in the middle of the Creek opposite the mill
machine and the jurors agree on this 1st day of October
present that the said Abraham Threlkeld is being overruled as jurors
did not keep the 1st public road of which ^{he} is the owner in
good order, in this that the said Abraham Threlkeld ~~as~~ ^{is} ~~overruled~~
agreed did not keep the said public road of which he is and there
was the Overruled well smoothed and thirty feet wide to wit
on the 1st day of October in the year 1843 and between that day
and the 9th day of October 1843, and further the jurisdiction
of this Court (the County Court of Rockingham not having
authorised by order entered of record as aforesaid) against the Statute
in such case made and provided and against the peace and
dignity of the Commonwealth
